



Last April, the First Nations Human Resources Development Commission of Quebec (FNHRDCQ) hired liaison officers to support the development of the workforce of several First Nations. One of these liaison officers will be dedicated exclusively to the Wolastoqiyik Wahsipekuk First Nation.

She will be responsible for establishing links between the WWFN, Services Québec, the labour market and educational institutions in order to meet the needs of the community and to accompany it in the development of skills and the professional integration of its members.

The liaison officer retained for the community is Mrs. Lisette Moreau. She is herself a Wolastoqiyik and has, in addition to a graduate degree, extensive experience in training and employment.

As part of her duties, the Liaison Officer wishes to develop a profile of the community to ensure a better match between the needs of the Wolastoqey workforce and those of the labour market. In this context, you may be asked to complete a short survey on your work experience or training needs.

The Liaison Officer will work closely with the Coordinator of the Employment and Training Services Centre (ETSC), Mrs. Marie-Christine Dubé and with the Director of Human Resources, Mrs. Catherine Plourde.
