The Cultural Committee is composed of eight (8) members, including the Research and Development Officer for Cultural Projects. The seven (7) other members must be members of the WWFN and totally independent of the political/administrative organization of the WWFN. **Two (2) positions on this committee are to be filled.**

The Cultural Committee meets a **minimum** of four (4) times per year and the length of each meeting varies between 3 and 6 hours. Members may attend via video conference or in person at their convenience (to be monitored as the COVID-19 pandemic evolves).

**The committee plays a privileged role within the Nation in all matters that affect cultural life.**

The cultural committee plays an advisory role and is responsible for making recommendations to the Grand Council in order to guide decisions in cultural matters. In addition, at the request of the Grand Council, the committee may be asked to support and/or accompany the development of certain projects to ensure their cohesion with the principles set out in the cultural affirmation document. The committee must be representative of the membership of the WWFN; therefore it will have at least one member from each of the major regions of occupation of the WWFN.

The Cultural Committee is composed of eight (8) members, including the Research and Development Officer for Cultural Projects.

### **Skills, knowledge and interests sought:**

Any member of the Cultural Committee shall:

- Be interested or willing to share knowledge in the following areas:
  - Traditional Wolastoqey culture;
  - Contemporary Wolastoqey culture;
  - Wolastoqey language Latuwewakon;
  - Traditional activities;
  - Wolastoqey Spirituality;
  - Wolastokuk Cultural Occupation;
  - Wolastoqey crafts;
- Enjoy discussing and making decisions as a team
- Be a member of **legal age** of the WWFN;
- Be available in person or via ZOOM videoconference to attend the **minimum** of four (4) annual meetings (ranging from 3 to 6 hours in length) and prepare for them by reviewing the agenda and any relevant documents **in advance**.
