

2025 COMMUNITY DISTRIBUTION

This year, the registration period for community distribution will open on July 21 at 8 a.m. and close on September 19 at 5 p.m.

As in previous years, we will not be able to fulfil all the orders we receive from members, so the first to register will be the first served until reserves are exhausted. Orders received by mail will be ranked by date according to when Canada Post cancelled the stamp.

The registration period for community distribution will run from July 21 to September 19, 2025.

Deliveries will take place from Friday to Sunday only, during daylight hours, making it easier for you travel and pick up your boxes. Deliveries will take place from December 5 to 7 and December 12 to 14. Keep your QR code coupons in a safe place, as they contain all the information about the date, time and place of delivery.

The contents of the fish box will differ from last year's box, and will have a few new surprises! The good news is northern shrimp is also making a comeback.

For this 2025 edition, the WWFN listened to the wish expressed at the 2024 General Assembly of members and is adding more white fish to the boxes.

This year, the WWFN will use two different types of vehicles for the distribution.

Refrigerated truck bearing the First Nation's logo for the following regions:

Tractor-trailer bearing the name "Les Crabiers du Nord" for the following regions:

Trois-Rivières / Berthierville / Laval / Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts

Sept-Îles / Sherbrooke / Mont Saint-Hilaire

General information

Community distribution will take place from December 5 to 7 and from December 12 to 14.

FISH BOX:

- Check the box indicating you want a fish box on the “2025 Community Distribution” form.
- Only one order per mailing address will be accepted.
- Pay the amount indicated (\$20) **by cheque or money order** for mail orders and by **credit card** for Web orders at the same time you fill out the online form.

GAME MEAT BOX:

- Check the box indicating you want a game meat box on the “2025 Community Distribution” form.
- Only one order per mailing address will be accepted.
- There is no charge for the game meat box.

You can submit your order by mail or via our website.

Mail order procedure:

- 1-** Fill out the attached form **in its entirety**.
- 2-** Enclose your payment for the fish box (\$20) by cheque or money order made payable to the WWFN.
- 3-** Mail the attached form with your cheque or money order before SEPTEMBER 19, 2025 (the date Canada Post cancelled the stamp will serve as proof) to the following address:

- 4-** You will receive a voucher with a QR code by email. If you don't have an email account, the voucher will be mailed to you. Check your email inbox and junk mail box regularly.
- 5-** During pick-up, show your QR code voucher(s) to the delivery staff.
- 6-** Delivery staff at the delivery sites will be equipped with QR code readers.

Web procedure

You have until SEPTEMBER 19, 2025 to place your online order.

- 1-** You must use a Google browser to register online.
- 2-** Visit wolastoqiyikwahsipekuk.ca.
- 3-** At the top of the page, select “Members’ Area.”
- 4-** Answer the questions to log in to the portal.
- 5-** Click the “Modify my profile” button. Your profile will open.
- 6-** Check the contact information that populates in the “My profile” field.
 - 1) Check that your email address is up-to-date and valid.
 - 2) Check that your email address is up-to-date and valid.
 - 3) If any information is incorrect, make the changes in the adjacent table and click the “Save changes” button.
Return to the dashboard.
- 7-** Click the “Community distribution” button.
- 8-** Read the general information for each box and select the box(es) you want.
Once you’ve made your choice, click the “Order” button.
- 9-** Check the information you’ve entered, select the desired distribution site and confirm your order.
Proceed with your credit card payment by entering the required information in the “Payment method” table.
Finish by clicking the “Place order” button.
- 10-** At the end of the transaction, the following window will appear: “Order successfully submitted.” If you don’t see the confirmation window, contact the First Nation at 1 888 399-2393 or 418 860-2393 ext. 220.
- 11-** Immediately after the “Order successfully submitted” window appears, pick-up voucher(s) bearing a QR code from “Wolastoqiyik Wahsipekuk First Nation Portal” will be emailed to you. Check your junk mail if you don’t receive the message.
- 12-** You can either:
 - Print the voucher and show it to the delivery staff when you pick up your order;
 - Keep the QR code on your mobile phone or tablet and show it to the delivery staff when you pick up your order;
 - Take a screenshot of your QR code and send it to the person who will be picking up your order.
- 13-** Delivery staff at the delivery sites will be equipped with QR code readers.
