RAFFLE RULES

1. All participants must hold a Wolastoqey member card recognized by the WWFN Citizen Code and show it upon request.
2. To hunt, participants must be 12 years or older on September 1, 2025. Participants must be available and present on site for the entire duration of the package.
3. Hunters must hold a hunter's certificate for firearms, bows or crossbows, or, alternatively, a WWFN-issued attestation for firearms, bows or crossbows.
4. Each member may only participate one time in each raffle category, i.e. as a hunter, fisher, or accompanying adult.
5. Complete and send the application forms and contract of engagement by email to info@malecites.ca or by post to 217 Rue de la Grève, Cacouna, Quebec G0L 1G0 **no later than Friday, March 14, 2025 at 4 p.m.** Please take postal delivery times into account.
6. The package must be selected at the time of the drawing, otherwise the group will automatically be placed on the list of substitutes. Group leaders shall be **present at the time of the raffle and ready to indicate their package preference.** They will have 2 minutes to make their choice. Once this time limit is expired, the group's number will be put back in the lottery drum. If it is drawn a second time, the leader should ensure he is ready to choose his desired zone. If he is still not ready, his group will be automatically placed on the list of substitutes. 7. Non-winning groups will be added to the list of substitutes and the order of priority will be determined by random drawing.

8. Unless indicated otherwise, no changes may be made to the composition of a hunting or fishing group once the raffle has begun. The only changes permitted are the addition of an accompanying adult or the removal of a fourth hunter. If a fourth hunter withdraws from the group, this individual forgoes his right to join another hunting or fishing group. WWFN shall be notified of any change no later than 20 working days prior to the start of the package.
9. Substituting a group member is permitted only in exceptional circumstances (death in immediate family, court summons, unforeseen medical issue). In the event of ambiguity, the matter will be decided by the WTAOC Committee.
10. Group leaders must undertake to abide by WWFN's hunting and fishing regulations by signing the contract of engagement. Leaders are also responsible for ensuring that the members of their respective groups comply with these regulations. The signed contract shall be submitted together with the application form.
11. Authorized accompanying adults: spouses or children of a WWFN member may participate as accompanying adults but are not permitted to hunt. For fishing trips, accompanying adults may only fish under the licence and catch limits of the WWFN member they are accompanying. The number of accompanying adults shall not exceed the number of hunters or fishers at the start of the trip.
12. All members indicated in the registration form (including accompanying adults) of a group that has been awarded a hunting or fishing package shall be present when registering their trip. If this rule is not complied with, all registered group members will be deemed ineligible to participate in the 2026 raffle.
13. Respect for other hunters, fishers, users as well as administrative staff (both of WWFN and structured territories) is of utmost importance. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. In the event of an incident, a report will be prepared and submitted to the relevant authorities, who will decide what penalties to apply.
14. For wildlife population tracking purposes, group leaders or individual participants shall declare and/or register any kill or catch prior to leaving the structured territory. Failure to meet this obligation will result in penalties for all members of the group.
15. A new permit for community kills is now in place. All community kills shall be pre-authorized by WWFN. Unauthorized kills will be considered a violation and will result in the guilty party being barred from the following year's raffle.
16. In order to avoid incidents, hunters shall comply with designated zones and hunting hours at all times, even during the post-season.
17. Any failure to comply with the rules by a group member will result in penalties that may include the exclusion of that member as well as the other members of his group from future raffles.

FISHING – RIMOUSKI AND DUCHÉNIER WILDLIFE RESERVES

- Two- or three-day packages on exclusive lakes for parties of at least 3 fishers who are WWFN members; chalet lodging included. Boats provided (outboard motor not included for Rimouski Wildlife Reserve).
- Children of Wolastoqiyik fishers below the age of 18 who do not hold a member card may fish at no cost under their parents' licence. If such individuals wish to fish under their own licence, they will be responsible for paying all associated fees.
- Please note that in Duchénier Wildlife Reserve, it is now forbidden to bring your own motor (gasoline or electric). In order to avoid contaminating the lakes, each boat will come with a motor provided by Duchénier Wildlife Reserve.

COMMUNITY FISHING ACTIVITY

- Opportunity to participate in fishing trips on exclusive lakes (boats provided but not outboard motor).
- As lodging is limited, chalets will be raffled off.
- Please note that in Duchénier Wildlife Reserve, the use of one's own personal motor (gasoline or electric) is now prohibited. For each watercraft, a motor will be provided by the reserve.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Group leaders are responsible for the conduct of accompanying adults and any damage they might cause during the course of the trip.
- Accommodations may be made for elderly participants and individuals with special needs (e.g. limited mobility).

CONTRACT OF ENGAGEMENT

- I hereby confirm that I am aware of the specific eligibility rules for packages and undertake to comply with them.
- I am responsible for the conduct and actions of the other members of my group and I undertake to share any necessary information with them so that they also abide by these rules.
- **I am aware that in the event these rules are not observed, penalties may be applied to the members of my group.**

WWFN PACKAGE RULES

- All hunters and fishers are required to hold a valid WWFN-issued licence when they arrive and have this licence on their person while practising their activities.
- Unless indicated otherwise, no changes may be made to the composition of a winning hunting or fishing group once the raffle has taken place. The only changes authorized are the addition of an accompanying adult or the removal of a fourth hunter. If the fourth hunter is removed from the list, this individual may not join another hunting or fishing party as a hunter or fisher.
- Substituting a group member is permitted only in exceptional circumstances such as a death in the immediate family, court summons, or an unforeseen medical issue.
- In the event of a cancellation or withdrawal, the package will be offered to substitutes in accordance with the administrative procedure put into place for such instances.
- Without exception, all group members including accompanying adults must be present for the entire duration of the package and shall sign a register upon arrival confirming their presence. Failure to meet this obligation will result in penalties for all members of the group.
- Group leaders or individual participants shall declare and/or register any kill or catch prior to leaving the structured territory. This procedure is critical for wildlife population monitoring purposes. Failure to meet this obligation will result in penalties for all members of the group.
- A new permit for community kills is now in place. All community kills shall be pre-authorized by WWFN. Unauthorized kills will be considered a violation and will result in the guilty party being barred from the following year's raffle.
- In order to avoid incidents, hunters shall comply with designated zones and hunting hours at all times, even during the post-season.
- Respect for other hunters, fishers, users as well as administrative staff (both of WWFN and structured territories) is of utmost importance. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. In the event of an incident, a report will be prepared and submitted to the relevant authorities, who will decide what penalties to apply.
- Any failure to comply with the rules by a group member will result in penalties that may include the exclusion of that member and the rest of his group from future raffles.

Online orders:

Please note that online orders will be processed within 48 hours and are subject to normal postal delivery times.

- 1) Visit the website wolastoqiyikwahsipekuk.ca.
- 2) At the top of the page, click on “**MEMBERS’ AREA**.”
- 3) Enter the requested information to log into the portal.
- 4) Click on “**Modify my profile**.” This will take you to your profile.
- 5) Verify the contact information that appears automatically in the “My profile” inset.
 1. If the information is correct, return to the dashboard.
 2. If incorrect, make the necessary changes in the adjacent table and click on “**Save changes**.” Return to the dashboard.
- 6) Click on “**My permits**.”
- 7) Read the general information for each permit and select the permit(s) desired. Once you have made your choice, click on the “**Submit application**” button.
- 8) Confirm your order by verifying the mailing information. To pay by credit card, enter the required information in the “**Payment method**” table. To complete, click on the “**Place order**” button.
